Port Augusta City Council discussions

The Environment Protection Authority (EPA) in its role as the environmental regulator of the former power station site regularly meets with the site's operator, Flinders Power, Port Augusta council and the community.

The EPA is meeting with council staff tomorrow as part of ongoing and regular contact with the council and will discuss short and long term management plans for Bird Lake.
