

# SA EPA 2006 NPI UPDATE

#### NPI in South Australia

Once again, the SA NPI Team saw an increase in the number of above-threshold NPI reports received from facilities, with 381 reports submitted for the 2004-2005 reporting period. This represents a 6.7% increase from the 2003-2004 figure of 357 reports.



There has been a constant increase in the number of reporters who are above threshold, both for South Australia and nationally.

We are continually looking to further increase the numbers by getting non-reporters on board. Please contact us if you are aware of any facilities that should be reporting!

## Online Reporting for the NPI

Online reporting for the NPI is currently being developed on a national basis; however, it will not be available for the 2005-2006 reporting period.

If your facility would like to volunteer to test the online reporting feature of the NPI, please contact the NPI Team so that we can keep you updated on the progress and when testing will commence. We hope to hear from you!

#### **Electronic Reporting**

In the meantime, while the online reporting is being developed, you can submit NPI reports electronically via the National Reporting Tool (NRT).

The SA NPI Team prefers NPI reports to be submitted via the NRT as this reduces the possibility of transfer errors.

## NPI Reporting Administrative Checklist

To assist you in checking whether you have filled out the NPI report correctly, follow this checklist:

- □ Have I used the correct units?
- □ Have I included an ANZSIC Code?
- □ Have I provided my location coordinates?
- □ Have I provided the correct ABN/ACN?
- Does my ABN/ACN correspond with what is on the ASIC web site?
- Have I ensured that I have not provided a PO box address under 'Facility address'?
- □ Have I compared this year's report with last year's report?
- □ Have I included explanations for large variations in usage or emissions?

Making sure that you comply with the above checklist assists the SA NPI Team, as your reports cannot be processed until all facility information is available.
