

When can I burn?

Inside Metropolitan Adelaide and townships

Preparation of food or beverage

No permit required

Use of brazier, chiminea or fire pit for heating outdoor area

No permit required. Charcoal only

Disposal of agricultural and forestry waste

By individual permit or general notice

Burning off for bushfire hazard reduction

By individual permit or general notice

Written consent of general notice is given by Authority or council

Outside Metropolitan Adelaide and townships

Preparation of food or beverage

No permit required

Use of brazier, chiminea or fire pit for heating outdoor area

No permit required. Charcoal, dry timber or other plant matter

Disposal of agricultural and forestry waste

No permit required. Burning must be in accordance with CFS Code of Practice for Board Acre Burning 2015 (where applicable)

Burning off for bushfire hazard reduction

No permit required. Burning must be in accordance with CFS Code of Practice for Vegetation Pile Burning 2015

Recreational purposes

No permit required. For campfires, scouting and outdoor activities

Written consent of general notice is given by Authority or council

Does not apply to burning undertaken in accordance with any permit issued or authority given under the *Fire and Emergency Services Act 2005*
