On 6 April 2020, the EPA wrote to the McLaren Vale community to advise that it had received an application from Southern Waste ResourceCo (SWR) to receive and dispose of per-and poly fluoroalkyl substances or ‘PFAS’ at its landfill on Main South Road. With the easing of social distancing restrictions, the EPA is now able to provide an opportunity for the local community to speak one-on-one with staff from the EPA, SWR and SA Health. Come along to find out more about the science behind the proposal, how it would need to be regulated, and the health research and advice that is relevant to South Australians.
