The non-compliance must be rectified and retested by an accredited compliance tester within the 60-day period.

Initial compliance testing when registering the apparatus for the first time.

Compliant test reports and COCs for the initial registration of the apparatus must be submitted to the EPA (email: rpb.compliance@sa.gov.au).

Cyclic testing

Compliant test reports and associated certificates of compliance for cyclic testing should not be submitted to the EPA but rather retained by the owner for the lifespan of the apparatus.

The failure relates to test protocol number/s:

- The failure is **a critical failure** and continued clinical use of the apparatus is **not permitted**.
- As the owner, you must immediately inform the EPA of the fault and ensure no clinical use of the apparatus is undertaken without the consent of the EPA and a rectification process agreed to.

- As the owner, you are also required to submit a copy of the entire test report outlining the critical failures to the EPA. Instructions on how to do this are on the back of this form.
