## Tips for submitting your report on time

Start your report early and ensure that NPI reporting is part of your internal procedures. This may mean including NPI reporting as part of a job description and writing an internal operating procedure on how to prepare a NPI report.

All NPI correspondence including reminder emails are directed to the technical contact. As such it is important that you inform us if your technical contact has left your

company or changed roles so that these contact details can be kept current.

The EPA recommends using the [Online Reporting System](#) (ORS) to ensure that your report is received on time. If you choose to submit a paper report, ensure that you send it with enough time to reach the EPA office by the due date or email a scanned version of the report.
