Viva Energy Australia Ltd. ("**Viva Energy**") formerly The Shell Company of Australia Limited, has written to five landholders near its Coles Express Mansfield Park service station (on the corner of Grand Junction Road and William Street), to advise them of environmental works that are to be conducted nearby to their properties.

The purpose of the works is to further investigate the extent of the groundwater impact identified from previous investigations.

A truck with a drill rig will be used as part of the works, and neighbours may hear noise during this period. Appropriate safety precautions will be implemented as part of the work plan, including barricading of the work areas and traffic management.

Viva Energy and its contractors will ensure that every effort is made to minimise noise and disruption while the work is being undertaken.

The works will be conducted between **Wednesday 11 February 2015** and **Friday 13 February 2015** during normal working hours (**8am to 5pm**) and in accordance with Council Approvals and Regulatory requirements.

The South Australian EPA has been informed of Viva Energy's environmental works and an independent Site Contamination Auditor has been appointed for this job. Viva Energy will continue to work with all relevant authorities.
